

Private Ice Rules

- 1) Skaters with their music playing have the right of way, followed by skaters in a lesson with a coach, and then skaters on their own.
- 2) No cell phones, headphones, drinks other than water, food/gum allowed on the ice. No food in the hockey boxes.
- 3) Bullying will not be tolerated and should be reported to a coach.
- 4) Groups standing and talking on the ice will be asked to disperse or leave the ice.
- 5) Parents/Spectators are asked to remain in the stands, not the hockey box, and not interrupt the skater's lesson.
- 6) Only skaters and coaches can put music in line
- 7) Skater's must come to the music box to tell the ice monitor they are there and how long they are skating.
- 8) Belts are only worn when the skaters program music is being played.
- 9) No cones or other objects are to be used on this ice, unless it is a prop/hoop/ribbon/ball etc. for program use.
- 10) No swearing, kicking the ice, hitting the board etc. You will be asked to leave.
- 11) Ice monitors, skaters, and coaches must treat each other with the utmost respect while on private ice.
